# **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AUTHORS**

#### Instructions for the authors:

#### **Editing criteria:**

The accepted publishing language is English.

This journal's paper should be between 4000 and 6000 words, including tables of contents, references, figure captions, and endnotes. The words and quotes in foreign languages should be written in Italics, while English quotes should be written in regular font. Every quote will be referenced according to APA Format 5 th Edition citation norms, in text, avoiding footnotes.

Every author shall insert his name below the paper's title, at the upper right side of the paper, with a footnote that shall stipulate: academic title, institution, city, country, and e-mail.

An abstract of 250-300 words shall precede every text; every abstract shall be followed by a maximum of 5 keywords, separated by semicolons. The recommended paper's structure contains an Introduction, Theoretical background, Methodology, Results, Discussions, and Conclusions.

Complete bibliographical references for works mentioned in the paper should be included as References at the end of the article.

Page setup: justified, line spacing: Multiple 1.2 Cambria 12; Paper Title: aldine (bold), Cambria 14p; Author(s) Name: Cambria, 12, bold, first page, the upper right side Text: Cambria, 12; line spacing Multiple 1.2; first paragraph indent: none; following paragraphs indent: 0.3 Abstract: Cambria, 11, italic, Multiple 1.2. Key-words: 3 to 5 key-words, Cambria, 12, single, separated by a semicolon. Identification footnote: Cambria, 10, single References: Cambria, 10, single, hanging at 0.3 References shall be written in APA style format.
